

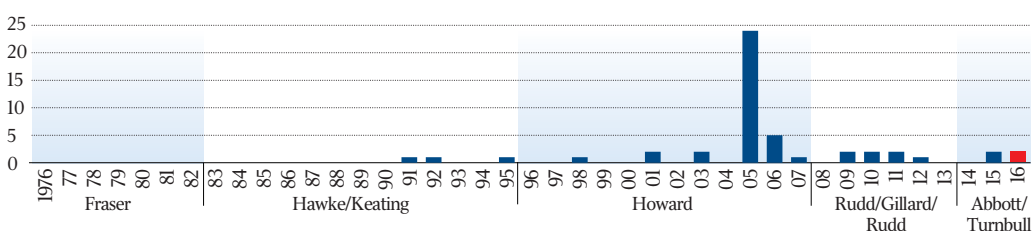

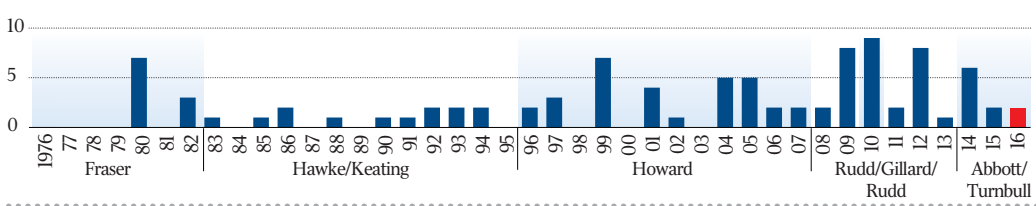

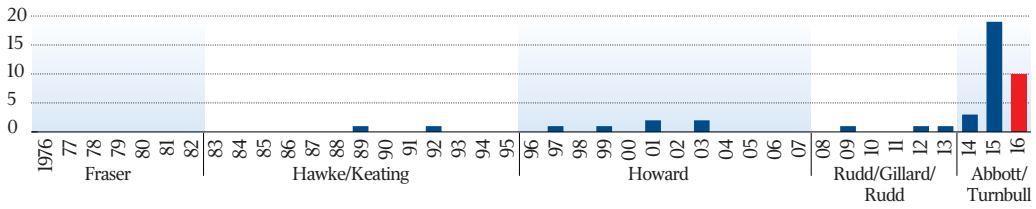
## Onus of proof breaches in current legislation, by year
